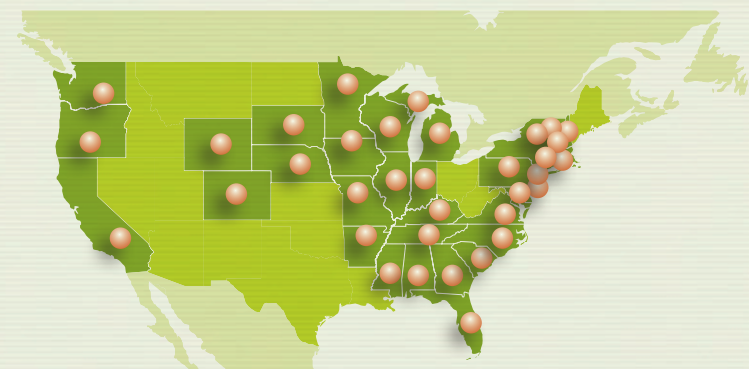

Bethany united hundreds of international children with adoptive families in the United States last year.

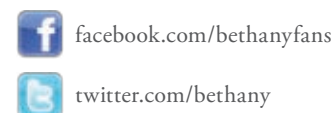
In Ethiopia, we now offer foster care.

Bethany's vision is for every child to grow up in the embrace of a strong, loving family.

Working with children around the world, Bethany offers pregnancy counseling, adoption, foster care, and a range of services to support and preserve families. In this report, you will see our work in 2010 summarized in numbers. While financial figures are critical, the numbers we are most proud of are the ones showing lives changed—such as the hundreds of children sponsored through Bethany last year. I recently talked to grandparents in Ethiopia who told me that sponsorship, along with a gift of sheep from the Gift Catalog, has enabled them to provide for their orphaned grandchildren. Previously, this family went hungry—now they are self-supporting. This is the impact of your partnership with Bethany. I thank you.

It has been a milestone year in many ways.

As the largest nonprofit adoption agency in the United States, Bethany placed 1,937 children with adoptive parents in 2010—the highest number in our history. We partnered with churches in nine locations to pilot an innovative interim care ministry, Safe Families for Children™. We launched 29 programs, opened three new offices, and started the first foster care program in Ethiopia. But among all these milestones, one thing stands out for me: Ten days after an earthquake struck Haiti last January, Bethany was able to fly out waiting children who were in the process of being adopted. It was deeply gratifying to unite these children with their forever families during this time of crisis.

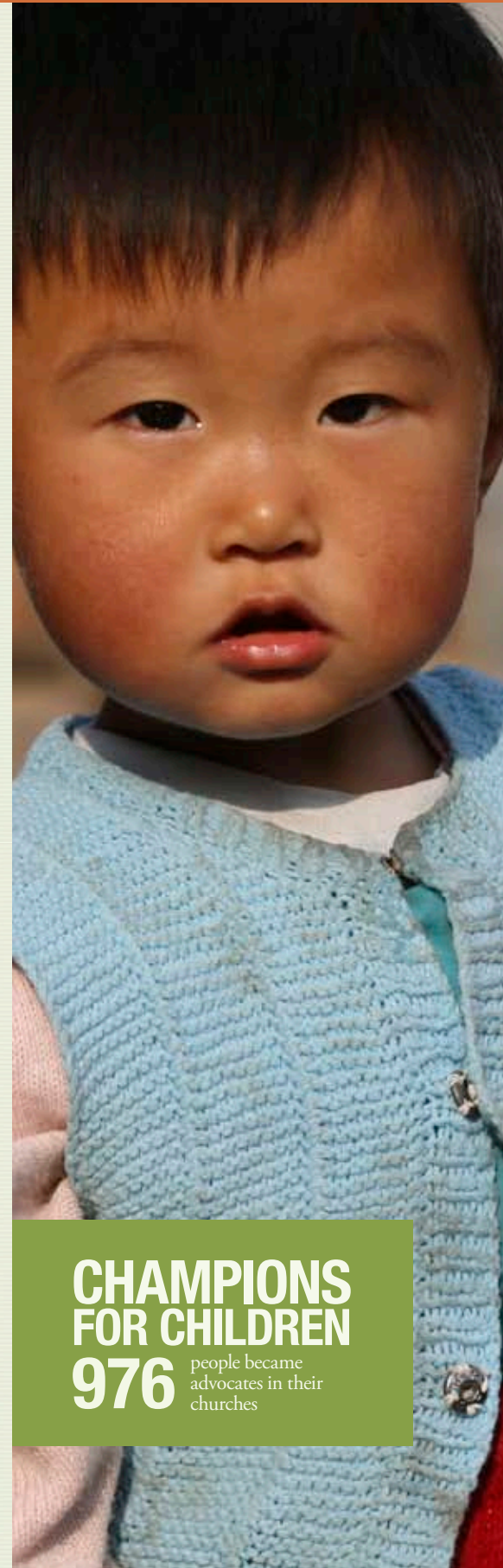
