## Healthy Marriage Initiative

On October 1, 2006, **Bethany** of Virginia was awarded a five year grant through the Administration for Children and Families, a division of Health and Human Services. This grant provides fund for **Bethany** to recruit mentors from the churches who will work with young unwed expectant parents. The couples may be considering marriage and will benefit from developing good communication skills and learning about budgeting and parenting.

Studies have shown that unwed expectant parents are more likely to think seriously about marriage because they are still very much romantically involved with each other. **Bethany** is excited about the opportunity to promote the biblical ideal of marriage. We live in a day when too many young people do not see how important it is for children to have two parents, a mother and a father who are together. This funding gives us an opportunity to educate and to provide mentoring relationships which may allow these new marriages to succeed.

In the first year of this grant, the Fredericksburg and Richmond areas are being targeted. A program manager will be hired as well as two case management specialists. Mentoring couples will be recruited from area churches and assigned to unwed expectant couples who express an interest in this program.

We are very excited about the new opportunities the grant money will provide, but we want you to know that these designated funds cannot be used to fund the pregnancy center aspect of **Bethany's** ministry. Please pray with us for wisdom as we implement this new venture. If you have a heart for marriage we hope you will consider becoming a mentor and serving with us in this way in 2007.

## From the Director

This has been a very exciting year for us here in Fredericksburg. We began the year

with the introduction of our new ultrasound services. We expected that we might see five or six women a month for a total of 60 or 70 women this year. Instead, at the writing of this newsletter, we have seen almost double that amount (111) women. We have been averaging 12-15 women a month and expect to end the year having provided limited obstetrical ultrasound examinations to 135-140 women. Even more exciting is the number of babies' lives who have been preserved as a result of this ministry. It is truly a miracle that many of these women have found **Bethany** and that they have had the opportunity to hear of Christ's love for them through the compassionate counsel of our nurse and other staff.

While we have been thrilled at the way God has been working and moving in the life of **Bethany**, we also need to honestly share our financial need at this time. We have served more than three times the number of women and families that we served last year, but we have only seen two birth mothers make adoption plans for their children. We have also had fewer families interested in adopting children. As a result, our revenue for these services has declined significantly. Though our donations have already increased by more than 20% over last year, we still face a need for additional funds to end the year without a deficit. In order to continue to serve pregnant women and preserve vulnerable babies in Fredericksburg, we ask that you consider how you might contribute to this ministry. **Please consider a year end gift which could help us end the year in the black.**

**Bethany** provides important services to this community and an opportunity to bring the Gospel of Christ to bear in situations where people are facing a crisis and are more willing to listen. We hope you will prayerfully consider how you can help this ministry succeed and grow in the coming years.
