

Director's Report

At the time of the writing of this report, we are already two-thirds of the way through this year. It has been amazing to see what God has done here at Bethany in the first eight months of 2006. To date we have seen 139 pregnancy counseling clients. Thirty-two of these clients received material resources. Eighty-three of them had ultrasound examinations. Twenty seven of the women who had ultrasound examinations were either abortion vulnerable or seriously considering abortion as a solution to their unplanned pregnancy. To date, not one of our clients has chosen to abort her child though one of the birth mothers probably would have done this if the ultrasound had not shown that her baby had already died. Two birth mothers have made the life affirming decision of making an adoption plan for their children.

Also this year, we have had nine families receive the gift of a child through domestic adoption and three families have welcomed four international children home. We anticipate that several more families will bring home children from other countries before the end of the year.

We are so grateful to you, our faithful supporters, who make it possible for us to minister in Christ's name to "the least of these". Please be praying with us as we consider how to expand our services here in Fredericksburg. We have been exploring ways in which we can support and encourage women who are planning to parent their babies so that these little ones can have a good beginning. We have also been looking at the possibility of adding testing for STIs, sexually transmitted infections. This would allow us to minister to men as well as to women. We are looking for new ways to have an impact in our community for good; ways in which we can bring the message of the gospel to bear on the lives of the people we see.

Will you pray with us that God would provide the funds to expand His work here in Fredericksburg? Pray with us also for wisdom with regard to any additional services God may want us to add to better serve the needs of children and families in our community.
