KINSHIP CARE SUPPORT GROUP

KINSHIP CARE is a term used to describe families in which a child is being cared for by a relative other than the child's biological parents.

Examples include children in the guardianship or custody (permanent or temporary) of grandparents or children in foster care with a relative, such as an aunt or cousin.

The Kinship Care Support Group meets twice a month. Topics and activities are planned by the group to address their concerns.

The adult group is led by a trained therapist who provides professional expertise, support, and educational information. The therapist coordinates the meetings, which may feature special speakers.

This group meets the needs of its members, so come and tell us what you would like to learn about! There is also plenty of time to talk, listen, and support one another.

Topics vary, but may include:

- Parenting Issues—discipline, behavior modification, etc.
- Healthcare Concerns—vaccinations, nutrition, etc.
- Social Skills—communication, friendships, etc.
