Starting in 2007, Bethany began offering a "full service" embryo adoption program which allows Bethany adoptive couples to be matched with embryos from Bethany donor couples. We currently have donor couples who are eager and waiting for their embryos to be matched with an adoptive couple. Please join us in praying that each of these embryos will have a chance at life! If you are interested in this option, please review the information below and contact the office for additional information.

### **What is embryo adoption?**

The embryos available for adoption through Bethany's program are typically frozen embryos remaining from couples who have successfully completed IVF and have completed their families. These donating couples do not want to destroy the remaining embryos and want them to have a chance at life. With embryo adoption, the adoptive mother carries the pregnancy. It is adoption (in a social/psychological sense) since the child is not genetically related to the adoptive parents. The medical procedure is a frozen embryo transfer in which the adopted embryos are transferred to the adoptive mother. If the procedure is successful, the pregnancy is monitored by the adoptive mother's ob/gyn. The success rate is specific to the medical clinic chosen by the adoptive family and the national average is 30% per cycle, though there are clinics with success rates as high as 56% per cycle.

**Bethany now offers full service embryo adoption:**

Serving Bethany donor couples AND adoptive couples.

Donors are now available and have received education and counseling through Bethany related to their donation decision.

Costs: \$6,600 for Bethany fees including home study, counseling, education, and matching services. Medical expenses are additional through local fertility clinic of your choice (medical tests, ultrasound and bloodwork, prescriptions, and transfer). Medical fees are specific to the clinic chosen by the adoptive couple (Bethany can help you research your options) and medical fees typically range from \$3,000 to \$4,500. Ultrasounds and bloodwork in preparation for transfer may be paid by insurance.
